

## Team Working Glossary

### **Formation** [COUNTABLE/UNCOUNTABLE]

the way in which a moving group of people or things is organized into a particular shape or pattern

- *Leeds played an attacking 4–3–3 formation.*
- *The soldiers broke into a run, keeping formation.*

### **in formation** (= in a fixed pattern):

- *planes flying in formation*

### **take turns or take it in turns**

(British)

if people take turns or take it in turns to do something, each of them does their share of it, one after the other

- *We took turns steering the boat.*

### **Praise** verb

to express strong approval or admiration for someone or something, especially in public

- *Mayor Dixon praised the efforts of those involved in the rescue.*
