

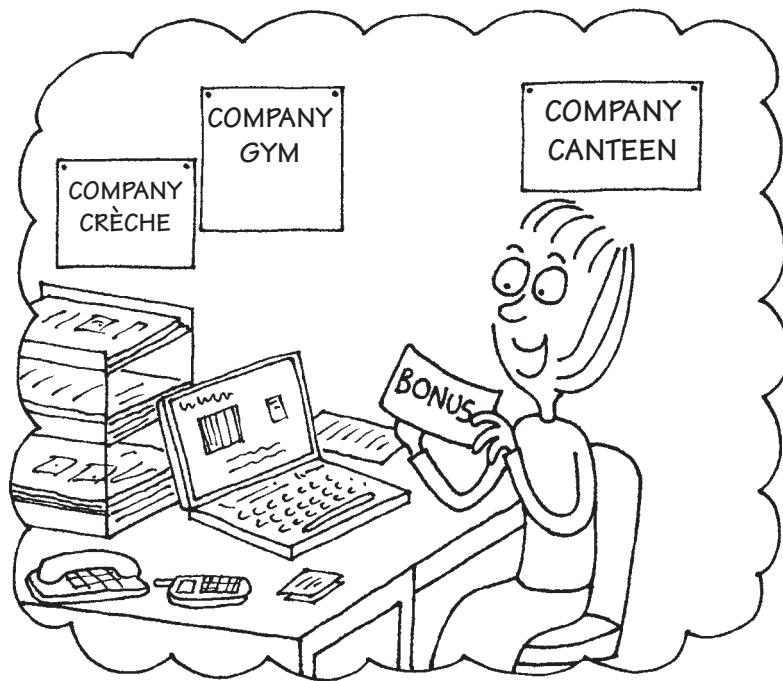

My ideal company:

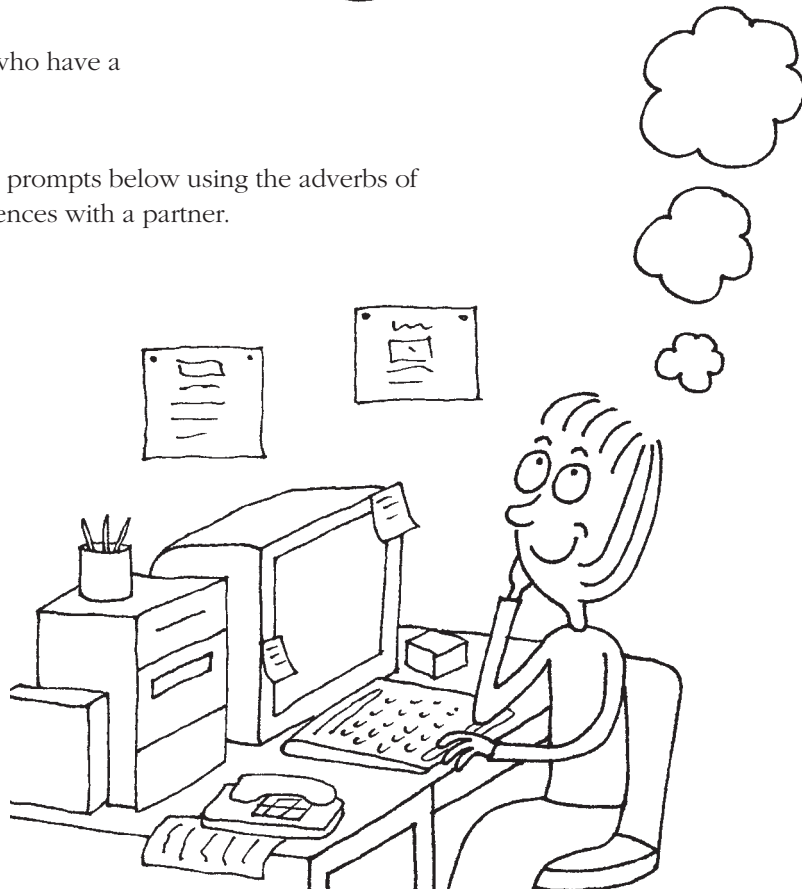
- has a female CEO
