Formation [COUNTABLE/UNCOUNTABLE]

the way in which a moving group of people or things is organized into a particular shape or pattern

- Leeds played an attacking 4–3–3 formation.
- The soldiers broke into a run, keeping formation.

in formation (= in a fixed pattern):

• planes flying in formation

take turns or take it in turns

(British)

if people take turns or take it in turns to do something, each of them does their share of it, one after the other

We took turns steering the boat.

Praise verb

to express strong approval or admiration for someone or something, especially in public

Mayor Dixon praised the efforts of those involved in the rescue.
